Little miracles of engineering

At DP Seals we've always enjoyed the challenge of micro-engineering small components and maintaining high quality no matter the size or intricate detailing.

After talking to our founder, David Piper, we discovered that he'd produced a moulding for a 0.007" (0.18mm) I/D O-ring the best part of 40 years ago, so we've obviously always been ahead of the game in custom rubber seals, gaskets and mouldings. Have a look at these hugely enlarged images from our Smart Scope and if you've got a tiny seal requirement coming up, bear us in mind.
